

## Supply List

### St. Thomas the Apostle – Second Grade

**EACH DAY** students should bring **AT LEAST** three masks, either disposable or cloth, as well as a personal-sized bottle of hand sanitizer to be kept at their desk.

Here is a list of supplies your child will need for the school year:

- 8 cursive writing books \$1.50 each (3 for homework, 2 LA, 1 creative writing, 1 math, 1 Spanish)

These items must be purchased in school. Please send \$12.00 in an envelope with your child's name on it by the first Friday of the school year. As the children complete each notebook, we will ask for an additional \$1.50 to cover the cost of each new book needed.

We may be asking for additional supplies during the year, but for now supplies needed from home and the items needed daily are:

- A pink eraser
- A small box of crayons – 16-24 count only, because any larger box will not fit in the desks and pencil cases. NO MARKERS, PLEASE.
- A glue stick
- A four-pack of low odor, chisel tip dry-erase Expo markers (any colors are fine. No fine-tip please.)
- 1 box of Ticonderoga SHARPENED #2 pencils
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 pair of safety scissors
- 1 box of erasable colored pencils
- 1 YELLOW highlighter
- A SOFT pencil case. The hard boxes do not fit in the desks. (MUST fit all items listed above)
- 1 large box of facial tissues
- 1 container of baby wipes
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes (i.e. Clorox or Lysol)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- Four folders (no side pockets, please and no folders with a glitter cover) One folder will be for daily use, one test folder, one Language Arts folder, and one Spanish folder.
- Computer mouse (wired preferred) \*Be sure to label with the child's name.
- 1 jumbo book sock
- Hefty 18 qt Storage Bin with Gray HI-RISE Stackable Lid (\$6.50 [Target Link](#))
- ART SUPPLIES (needed when students start doing art in school)
  - White eraser (Pentel Hi-Polymer Block eraser sold on Amazon 4pk/\$3.79)
  - Sketchbook
  - Scissors
  - Large glue stick
  - 2 sharpened pencils
  - 24 pack of crayons
  - Tempera sticks (you can use last year's if you have them)

1. Please label all supplies with your child's name including lunch boxes, clothing, and backpacks.
2. All supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year.
3. ALL HARD covered books are to be covered in either a paper book cover with the book title and your child's name on the front cover or with a book sock that fits properly.
4. ALL SOFT workbooks must be covered in CLEAR contact paper. Many of the workbooks are the same size, and clear contact enables your child to find the proper book more easily. It also lasts longer.

Technology Fee: All students in grades 1-8 will be given a Chromebook or laptop to use while they are a student at St. Thomas the Apostle. Devices for students in grades 1-4 will be kept in the school building, however students in grades 5-8 will be bringing them home nightly to complete assignments. All students will be charged a technology fee, which is still to be determined. As soon as an acceptable fee is decided upon by the administration, families will be notified and the fees will be collected.

Class Fee: \$35 – Due September 10, 2021. This fee is for special occasions, seasonal parties, and the Diocesan Home School Association Dues. Please send cash in an envelope with your child's name on it. If you choose to pay by check, please make the check payable to **St. Thomas the Apostle School**, however cash is preferred.
