

Supply List
St. Thomas the Apostle – Fifth Grade

ALL STUDENTS are asked to come to school **EACH DAY** with the following:

- AT LEAST 3 masks (cloth or disposable)
- A personal-sized bottle of hand sanitizer (to be kept at their desk)

Here is the supply list broken down into specified subjects. Please be sure to **label all items** clearly with ***your child's name, homeroom, and subject.*** We may be asking for additional supplies during the year, but for now supplies needed from home and the items needed daily are:

Language Arts

- 1 two-subject notebook
- Book for independent reading
- English Pocket Dictionary/Thesaurus

Social Studies/Science/Geography

- 2 one-inch flexible 3-ring binders with college ruled loose leaf (Science, Social Studies)
- 1 college ruled composition notebook (Geography)
- 1 **jumbo** book sock

Spanish

- 2 one-subject composition notebooks

Math

- 1 calculator (simple, non-graphing, need not be expensive)
- **6-inch** plastic ruler
- 2 folders (one for tests and one for classwork)
- 2 **graphing** notebooks

Daily necessities

- 1 box of **SHARPENED** pencils
- 1 large glue stick (no liquid glue)
- Colored pencils
- 3 different colored highlighters (must fit in pencil case)
- Scissors (with rounded tip)
- Navy blue, black, and red pens (no erasable pens)
- 1 SOFT SIDED pencil case (must fit all items listed above)
- 1 7-pocket accordion folder (labeled for each subject)
- 1 sturdy bottom pocket folders (Home folder/Test folder)
- Student planner/composition notebook (for daily journal)
- Computer mouse (wired or wireless) *Be sure to label with child's name.
- Case for laptop/Chromebook (at least 16 inch) Devices WILL NOT be issued to students without a case
- 2 boxes of tissues

- 2 rolls of paper towels

Technology Fee: All students in grades 1-8 will be given a Chromebook or laptop to use while they are a student at St. Thomas the Apostle. Devices for students in grades 1-4 will be kept in the school building, however students in grades 5-8 will be bringing them home nightly to complete assignments. All students will be charged a technology fee, which is still to be determined. As soon as an acceptable fee is decided upon by the administration, families will be notified and the fees will be collected.

Class Fee: \$35 – Due September 10, 2021. This fee is for special occasions, seasonal parties, and the Diocesan Home School Association Dues. Please send cash in an envelope with your child's name on it. If you choose to pay by check, please make the check payable to **St. Thomas the Apostle School**, however cash is preferred.
